The Challenge

After investing a significant amount of money on Thomas Built buses from Midwest Bus Sales, the North Kansas City School District (NKCSD) experienced break-ins, catalytic converter theft, and bus destruction in their lot during off-hours.

The Solution

Using Avigilon's combination of state-of-the-art hardware and object classification plug-ins via the ACC7 interface, ADS developed a solution using 16 Avigilon analytic cameras with built-in rules that trigger events detecting true threats to their facility. To keep the site safe, ADS went a step further and provided video monitoring during off-peak hours. ADS' real-time interaction via remote voice down is a key feature that has proven to be a game changer. If a threat reaches the site after hours, ADS' solution not only contacts local law enforcement, but also allows their monitoring staff to initiate voice down engagement with the trespassers through the IP speaker system provided by ADS.

The Result

Thanks to the new system, many attempts to harm NKCSD property have been prevented - saving thousands in damages. The increase in asset protection around the site has provided NKCSD greater peace-of-mind for years to come.
